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# Reflections on Teachers' Professional Ethics in Colleges and Universities

# 3. Problems in teachers' professional moral cultivation in colleges and universities

Such behavior seriously disrupts the teaching order and the relationship between teachers and students and has an adverse impact on students' physical and mental health as well as on social morality.

#### 3.3. Discrimination or favoritism towards students

Teachers in colleges and universities should treat every student equally and respect their individuality and differences. However, some teachers discriminate against or favor students, for example, giving special care to some students and being indifferent or discriminating against others. Such behavior seriously undermines

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the rights and interests of students and the fairness of education.

## 3.4. Incorrect working attitude

Teachers in colleges and universities should fulfill their duties and work assignments conscientiously with a high sense of responsibility and dedication. However, some teachers have improper working attitudes, such as working perfunctorily, delaying work, and not seriously preparing for classes and giving lessons. Such behavior seriously affects the quality of teaching and the effectiveness of education.

# 3.5. Lack of professional ethics

#### 3.7. Violation of professional norms

However, some teachers violate professional norms, such as irregular operation and abuse of power in enrolment and examination. This kind of behavior not only violates professional norms but also damages the teachers' professional moral image and social credibility.

To sum up, there are various problems of professional moral cultivation among college teachers, including academic misconduct, inappropriate teacher-student relationships, discrimination or favoritism to students, improper working attitude, lack of professional ethics, disrespect for others' intellectual property rights, violation of professional norms, and so on. In order to improve teachers' professional moral cultivation and social responsibility, colleges and universities should strengthen the education and training of teachers, establish a perfect supervision mechanism and management system, and at the same time, strengthen social supervision and public opinion guidance, so as to jointly promote the development and progress of education.

# 4. Measures to improve college teachers' professional moral cultivation
