- (2) It is necessary to build a multi-level and multi-channel training system, including setting up rural landscape design majors in higher education, continuing education and training for on-the-job designers, and setting up design workshops for rural communities [15].
- (3) Art comes from life, designers can also go deep into the countryside to experience rural life, and constantly enhance the perception and identity of rural culture, to lay the groundwork for them to integrate
