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Exploration of the Significance and Pathways of Integrating Traditional Culture into Aesthetic Education in Colleges and Universities

Some colleges and universities integrate traditional ethnic arts, such as Yi Siqiang and Shanxi Qinqiang, into their aesthetic education courses, and invite inheritors to enter the campus. Through live performances and production techniques, while giving students a strong visual impact, they can also guide them to think about how to effectively integrate national culture into artistic works, and transform their ideas through practice and exploration so that they have a new serious about how to create beauty ^[9].

3.1.2. Focus on regionalization

Students can be guided to copy mural paintings or make independent innovations, and perceive the charm of the culture through practical experience. Some colleges and universities have combined the traditional cultural characteristics of the region to create their string songs and live-action dramas. These works are not only reflected in the paper but also implemented in action. Once performed, they have triggered hot discussions [11]. In addition, the university also actively invites folk inheritors to come to the university and has set up its own dance troupe and folk orchestra. Some colleges and universities build Bridges of communication between people through musical instrument workshops and learning platforms, which not only cultivates students' artistic quality but also shows the powerful effectiveness of aesthetic education [13].

On the other hand, teachers should also combine theory and practice, and organize practical activities when systematically teaching cultural knowledge, so as to improve students' aesthetic quality and art appreciation ability through practice. In order to build the curriculum system, the construction of teaching staff should also be strengthened. Not only should we pay attention to the cultivation of teachers' comprehensive literacy such as
